

FAQ'S Pre-Matric Scholarship to OBC students from class I to X

Question	Answer
Who are eligible to apply for Scholarship Schemes?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Students studying in schools of UT Chandigarh from class I to X.</li> <li>(ii) Student must belong to OBC (other backward class).</li> <li>(iii) Attendance in the previous class should be above 60%.</li> <li>(iv) Student should have promoted from the previous class.</li> <li>(v) Student should have their own account in any bank and the account should be linked with student's aadhar card.</li> <li>(vi) Parents income less than ₹2,50,000.</li> </ul>
Is Aadhar required?	Yes, The Aadhar number is required to be seeded (linked) with the bank account in which Scholarship amount is desired to be transferred.
It is paid every year?	Yes, it is being renewed every year during the course of study. The award will be discontinued if a student fails to secure annual promotion except in case of unavoidable reasons to be certified by the competent authority of the scheme.
Tenability of Scholarship	The scholarship amount will be payable from the date of joining to the date of leaving the school, excluding the period of vacation, which will be about 10 months in a year except in the cases where the students enters late or leaves early in the midst of academic year.
Whether the students who are pursuing studies in Private Educational Institution can apply for the Scholarship?	Yes, the scholarship will be tenable only in such institutions and for such pre-matriculation courses, which have been duly recognized by the concerned State Government and UT Administrations.
Whether the student can apply for different Scholarship Schemes for different courses during the same academic year?	No, the student can apply for only one particular Scheme during the same academic year.
What is the coverage value of scholarship and ad-hoc grant?	<p>For <b>day-scholars</b> - ₹ 100/- per month for 10 months from class I to X</p> <p>For <b>hostlers</b> - ₹ 500/- per month for 10 months from class III to X.</p> <p>An <b>ad-hoc grant</b> of ₹ 500/- per student per annum to all students i.e. hostlers as well as day scholars will also be given.</p>
