

FAQ (Frequently Ask Questions)

S.No.	Question	Answer
01	Who can apply for the Scholarship Scheme?	Only Scheduled Tribe (ST) students of Jammu & Kashmir UT are eligible for the Scheme who are studying in Class 9 th and 10 th .
02	What should be the Total Family Income Per Annum?	The Total Family Income should not exceed Rs. 2.50 Lakhs Per Annum from all Sources.
03	Who should be the Competent Authority for issuing the Income Certificate?	The Income Certificate should be issued by the concerned Tehsildar Only, in case of parents/guardians Government Employee/Pensioner the Salary/Pension Certificate must be issued by the concerned DDO/Treasury Officer.
04	Whether the student can apply for different Scholarship Schemes for different Courses during the same academic year?	No, the student can apply for only one particular Scheme/Course during the same academic year.
05	Whether the students who are pursuing their studies in Private Educational Institutions can apply for the Scholarship?	Yes, subject to the concerned Institutions must be recognized by the Central/State Government etc.
06	Whether the entire fee paid by the student is being provided in full or not?	The Scholarship is being provided under the Scheme as per the Guidelines of the Scheme issued by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs Gol.
07	What is the procedure for applying to Scholarship?	Students can apply for Scholarship through National Scholarship Portal by visiting the website: www.scholarships.gov.in
