2 YEAR PRE-SERVICE STUDENT TEACHERS UNDERGOING D.EL.ED COURSE AT DIETS AND CTTC SOHRA

As per the RTE Act 2009, Section 23(i), appointment of elementary school teachers shall be eligible after possessing a minimum qualification of Class XII above with D.El.Ed. Taking this into account, the Education and Department/DERT has launched the two years Diploma in Elementary Education for Pre-Service candidates in all the 7 DIETs since the month of April the year 2012. This course offers a scholarship of Rs 5000/- p.m for 10 months. It is expected that the course will continue as scheduled to address quality issues in area of Elementary schooling in Meghalaya.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ To attract the best talent to take up teaching as a profession.
- ✓ To provide high-quality education services to students in rural areas.
- ✓ To ensure that specific areas of work force need to address and contribute to enhance students learning outcome.
- ✓ To provide additional resources for DIETs in strengthening areas not covered by Central Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for teacher education

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION:

• **Advertisement**: Wide publicity will be given in the Local Newspapers.

1. Minimum qualification:

- Class XII passed or its equivalent examination from recognized Boards/Councils with 50% marks with 5% relaxation for ST/SC/OBC/PWD.
- Candidates waiting for Class XII results amy also apply provided they produce their provisional/original documents at the time of counselling.
- There will be block wise allocation of seats to facilitate availability of trained teachers locally in the respective blocks.

2. Age:

• The minimum Age limit is 18 years and maximum age is 27 years as on 01.01.2020 relaxation up to 5 years for SC/ST/OBC/PWD.

3. Selection Procedure:

- Entrance Test.
- Counselling
- The selection procedure will be based on merit as per block quota.

4. Reservation Policy:

- As per Meghalaya Government Reservation Policy for different communities of the state.
- 5% of the seats will be reserved for persons with disabilities.

5. How to apply:

- Candidates can apply online at the website http://megeducation.gov.in/dert/dert.html.
- Candidates are advised to read the instructions carefully given in the website before applying for the same.
- Candidates must upload a scanned copy of a recent colour passport size photograph and a scanned copy of the signature.

- ➤ Waiting list candidates should be selected equivalent to the intake capacity of the institute.
- ➤ The number of candidates for each counselling shall be decided by the respective DIETs.
- ➤ In case the number of selected candidates are less than the intake capacity, in such cases the institution should gave preference from waiting list from other districts as well.
- ➤ Allotment of seats are:

Atleast 30% of the seats to be allotted to candidates having Science and Mathematics background at Class – XII level.

> Selected candidates will have to open an Account at the State Bank of India at the districts that they are selected for scholarship


